A judgment according to specific criticisms

On the volume of work, the presentation and organisation (information units for an interactive digital tool), the quality of content, the originality, the international scope, the degree of interactivity of the digital tool, the overall impression given to the reader of the book or the user of digital tool.

Specialized readers in many countries

University professors, journalists, writers, scientists, historians, sommeliers, œnologists, lawyers and other sector professionals: several readers evaluate each submitted work.

Books must be delivered at OIV **BEFORE** February 28. **Shipping Customs costs to the sender.** Precise value 0 on the package.

The pdf of the book or the URL address of digital tool **must be sent free of charge** to jurydesprix@oiv.int.

The OIV Award Jury's Committee will relay them to the designated OIV readers without author's or publisher's permission.

The download of the .pdf of the book must not require the downloading of professional software or the registration on a site (university type) to access it. **It must be available as a downloadable .pdf or in Open access, non-commercial selling.**
