II.3.5.4 Hot bottling

Definition:

Bottling of wine heated prior to the immediate corking of the bottle.

Objectives:

- a) Biological stabilisation of the wine;
- b) Elimination of oxygen;
- c) Physico-chemical stabilisation.

Prescription:

The wine should not be heated above 45°C.
