

## **I.2.1 Grape must**

Liquid product obtained from fresh grapes, whether spontaneously or by physical processes such as: crushing(\*)<sup>[1]</sup>, removing stems from grape berries or crushed grapes (\*)<sup>[2]</sup>, draining(\*)<sup>[3]</sup>, pressing (\*)<sup>[4]</sup>.
