# **Chapter 3: Wines**

# **Hot bottling**

#### **Definition:**

Bottling of wine heated prior to the immediate corking of the bottle.

### **Objectives:**

- a. Biological stabilisation of the wine;
- b. Elimination of oxygen;
- c. Physico-chemical stabilisation.

### **Prescription:**

The wine should not be heated above 45°C.

#### **Recommendation of the 0.1.V.:**

Accepted.
