




World Vineyard Surface Area

Vineyards destined for the production of all types of grapes, including both bearing and non-bearing areas












Global Wine Production

Wine production refers to the production of wine excluding musts and juices








Wine Production Volatility

Volatility indicator refers to the y-o-y variation of the global wine production volume












Global Wine Consumption




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Global Wine Supply Demand Balance



The index refers to the percentage of wine consumption that comes from imports










Average export price: €3.60 per litre






International Trade in Wine

International trade of wine refers to import/export of wine (HS code 2204)

Asia = **70%** production




Market Internationalisation Index = **15%**

Table grape refers to fresh grape destined for direct human consumption












Market Internationalisation Index = **75%**
