CALL FOR ABSTRACTS OIV-2026

The **47th World Congress of Vine and Wine and the 24th General Assembly of the International Organisation of Vine and Wine (OIV)** will take place from **12 to 16 October 2026 in Yinchuan, Ningxia**, at the invitation of Government of **People's Republic of China**.

This event will the world's leading specialists in the fields of viticulture and oenology, as well as world-class health, safety, law and economy experts involved in the vine and wine sector.

This 47th Congress will address issues linked to the future challenges of the vine and wine sector under the following theme:

**“Shaping New Paradigms for the Global Vine and Wine Sector:
Transforming to Meet Challenges, Innovating to Ignite Vitality, and
Sustaining to Anchor a Shared Future.”**

The four sessions for which papers can be submitted are structured as follows:

1. Session I. Viticulture. “Integrated Approaches to Resilient and Sustainable Grape Production”
2. Session II. Oenology. “Technical innovation and adapt oenology to the future of wine”
3. Session III. Economy & Law. Resilient legal and economic model within a Changing Market
4. Session IV. Safety & Health. Better Production, Better Consumption: Health and Social Sustainability at the Heart of the Vitivincultural Chain

As such, **the whole scientific community is invited to send in their presentations** on any of the issues contemplated for the various sections of the Congress. Please follow the instructions specified in the attached document when submitting your proposals.

The deadline for the submission of abstracts is 31 May 2026 and the deadline for sending in the final paper for accepted presentations is 30 September 2026.

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMITTING PAPERS

A. GENERAL INFORMATION

The papers need to reflect subject-related scientific expertise and need to be submitted via the communication platform of the congress for submitting papers <https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=2026oivcongress>

The following three types of presentation are possible:

- I. Oral presentation (15-20 minutes)
- II. Short presentation (5-10 minutes)
- III. Poster

B. PROCEDURE

Step n° 1

1. Authors set up a user account on the website <https://easychair.org/account/signin> by entering data into the fields marked by an * (mandatory fields). With username (e-mail address) and password authors are given access the communication platform of the 47th World Congress of Vine and Wine.

Step n° 2

1. Please connect to the communication platform of the congress <https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=2026oivcongress> with e-mail address and password.
2. Select “New Submission” on the upper bar and fill in the required fields.. In this context, the following points need to be taken into account:
 - Select one of the proposed sections and the sub-themes for your contribution.
 - Authors need to define the type of presentation (oral presentation, short presentation or poster).
 - All participating authors shall be listed by their names, E-mail, country and affiliation, starting with the principal author.
 - If an oral presentation or a short presentation is selected, it is necessary to indicate among the authors, the name of the corresponding author and the name of the presenter.
 - Organisers would like to point out that the registration of the presenter is mandatory.
 - A title describing the paper shall be given. Ideally, the title should comprise between 10 and 12 words.
 - To propose a paper, an abstract shall be submitted. The abstract should be as informative as possible and provide an overview of the presentation. The abstract should not exceed 4,000 characters (including spaces) per language version.



- The proposal for a presentation shall be submitted in English and two other official languages of the International Organisation of Vine and Wine (German, French, Italian, Spanish and Russian).

Authors can retrieve and edit your proposals for presentations until the end of the deadline for submissions.

The deadline for the submission is **31 May 2026**

Step n° 3

The submitted papers will be evaluated by the Reading and Selection Committee. In doing so, the following criteria will be applied:

- Scientific and sectoral relevance.
- Scientific and methodological quality.
- Originality and contribution to innovation.
- Interest and applicability at national and/or international level.

The Reading and Selection Committee takes the final decision on the adoption or rejection of a proposed paper.

The final type of presentation shall be determined by the Reading and Selection Committee. If the committee does not select a presentation as an “oral presentation“, the paper can still be accepted as a short presentation or poster.

The Reading and Selection Committee reserves the right to attribute the presentation to another than the proposed section or subtheme.

Author will be informed of the decisions taken by the Reading and Selection Committee from **22 June 2026**. The rules for the final papers submission which will be published as congress proceedings (oral presentation, short presentation and poster) will be made available

Step n° 4

The final version of the accepted paper to be published as congress paper shall be submitted within the deadline for submitting papers using your user account on the communication platform of the congress for submitting papers.

- Information about the decision of the Reading and Selection Committee: from **22 June 2026**
- Deadline for the final papers submission which will be published as congress proceedings: **30 September 2026**.

PUBLICATION AND INDEXATION POLICY FOR CONGRESS PROCEEDINGS

Authors of selected oral presentations who submit their paper in English, or in one of the other OIV languages with a title and abstract in English, will have the opportunity to publish their work in the **IVES Conference Series** <https://ives-openscience.eu/category/ives-conference-series/oiv>. This is an open-access journal dedicated to the publication of conference proceedings in the field of vine and wine.

All the articles published will have a stable internet identity, which facilitates and provides for consistent identification and citation.

More specifically,:

- each article will be given a **DOI (Digital Object Identifier)**, which enables the permanent identification of the document on the web, facilitates the use of bibliographic databases and produces more reliable and sustainable citations;
- each article will be published under Creative Commons Attribution (CC BY 4.0) license
- Authors retain copyright and grant the journal right of first publication with the work simultaneously licensed under a CC-BY 4.0 license allowing others to share the work with an acknowledgment of the work's authorship and initial publication in this journal.
- Authors retain copyright and are free to post their accepted papers on personal or institutional web sites, or to disseminate them in any other way, immediately after acceptance
- **Users** are free to read, download, copy and print submissions, search content and link to published articles, disseminate their full text and use them with the mandatory reference to the article's authors and initial publication in IVES Conference Series.

Authors should **provide a license for publishing the article with IVES Conference Series**.

If the author does not want an electronic reference for their article because the work has already been published in another scientific journal, only the abstract will be included in the compilation of communications available during the Congress.
