**About the OIV**

The International Organisation of Vine and Wine (OIV) is an intergovernmental organisation that establishes scientific and technical standards for the global vine and wine sector. Among its core missions is the collection, processing, analysis and dissemination of sectoral data.

**Role description**

Under the authority of the Director General and the supervision of the Head of the Statistics Department, the selected intern will be involved in the following tasks:

- a. Conducting online data research and extraction
- b. Verifying data for completeness, consistency, and accuracy
- c. Analysing international datasets and market information to identify trends and sector developments
- d. Developing statistical indicators and data visualisations
- e. Supporting the production of OIV's statistical outputs (e.g., *World Wine Production Outlook*, *OIV Thematic Focus*)
- f. Assisting in the preparation and organisation of conferences and official OIV meetings
- g. Supporting the coordination of statistical projects and departmental activities as required

**Internship conditions**

- 1 Working hours: 35 hours per week
- 2 Allowance: approx. €650 / month + specific compensation scheme (contribution to public transport tickets and meals)
- 3 Working arrangement: this internship is office-based and requires the intern's physical presence at OIV Headquarters in Dijon for the entire duration of the internship.
